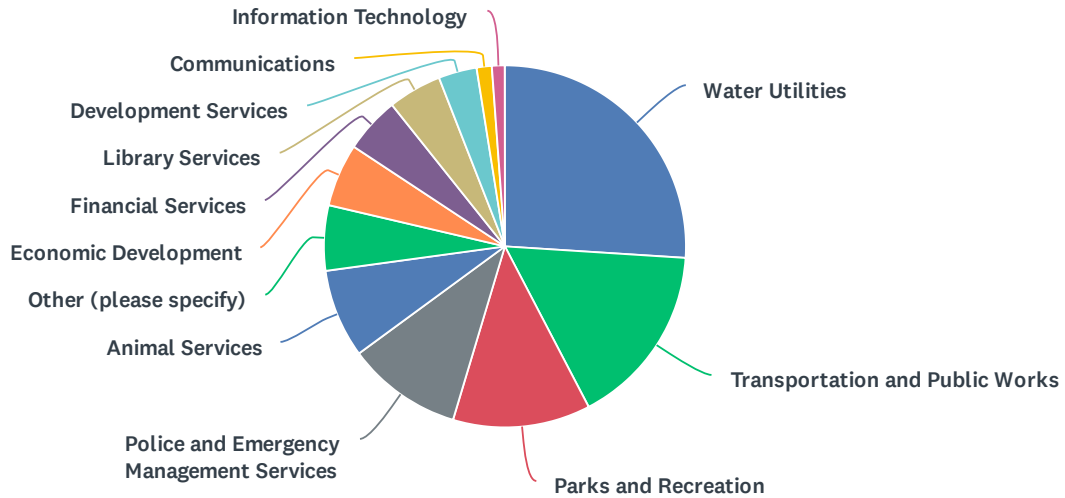

What is your age?

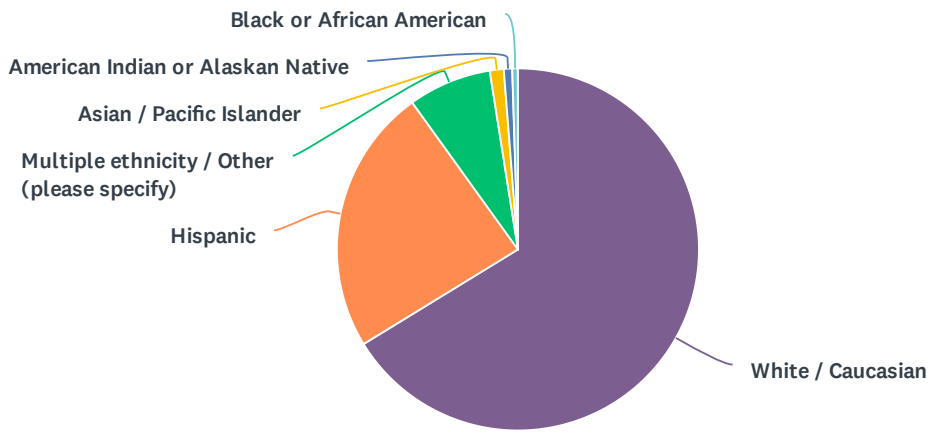

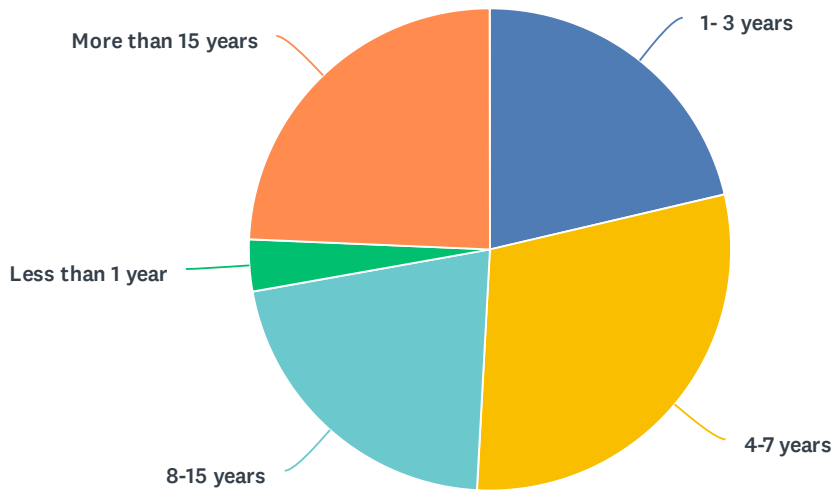

How long have you lived in the City of Kyle?

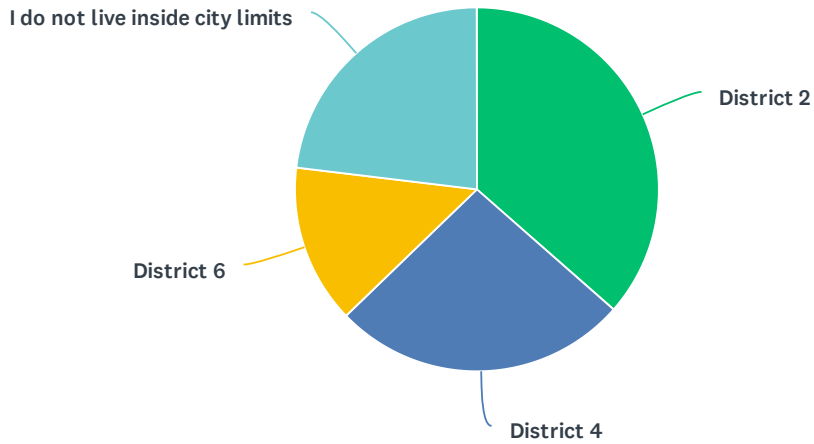
