

Family comedy magic show, featuring theater arts, music, mind-boggling magic tricks, mesmerizing mind-reading stunts, and exciting audience participation.




DANIEL G. BENES SCIENCE SHOW THURSDAY, JUNE 26 @ 2 PM

Read for a total of 45 days to receive a completion certificate and an entry ticket for one of our grand prizes. There are different prizes for youth, teens, and adults.


