Organic Information:

- a. USDA Organic label: Many products in the gardening world may have the words "Natural" or "Organic" in their name. Without one (or both) of the above symbols on the package.
- b. Some products, though not listed as organic or not approved by the OMRI, may still be used. The approval is based on the products having an insignificant amount of non-organic material because of processing or formulation.
- c. Approved Organic Products Include:
 - i. Medina products
 - ii. Neptune Fish Fertilizer
 - iii. Lady Bug brand products
 - iv. Bonemeal
 - v. Horticultural Molasses
 - vi. Compost Tea
 - vii. Super Thrive
- d. Pest and disease control products (listing is either active ingredient or brand name)
 - i. Neem (Neem should be listed as the ONLY active ingredient.)
 - ii. Bt (bacillus thuringiensis)
 - iii. Spinosad
 - iv. Diatomaceous Earth (DE) (DE should be listed as the ONLY active ingredient)
 - v. Insecticidal Soap
 - vi. Serenade (bacillus subtilus)
 - vii. Organicide
 - viii. Oil-based (Thyme, Wintergreen, Sesame, Clove) sprays
 - ix. Garlic-based sprays
 - x. epper (capsaicin) sprays
 - xi. Bonide Garden Dust
- e. The following products are NOT allowed at any time within the Community Garden:
 - i. Dillo Dirt
 - ii. Ilorganite
 - iii. City of Austin free compost
- f. This list is not complete and will be reviewed and updated as necessary. This list is considered the only approved and official list of authorized products for use in the garden. If you wish to use a product that is not listed as approved, you must contact the Garden Manager prior to use. The goal of the City of Kyle is to create a safe environment for the garden, gardeners and the community, not to limit the materials used.
- g. The City of Kyle maintains a fund to cover the purchase of organic products for plot use.
- h. The City of Kyle covers nematodes once a year for the Community Garden.
- i. The City of Kyle will provide a shelving unit within the tool shed for storage of organic items and a list of their uses.
